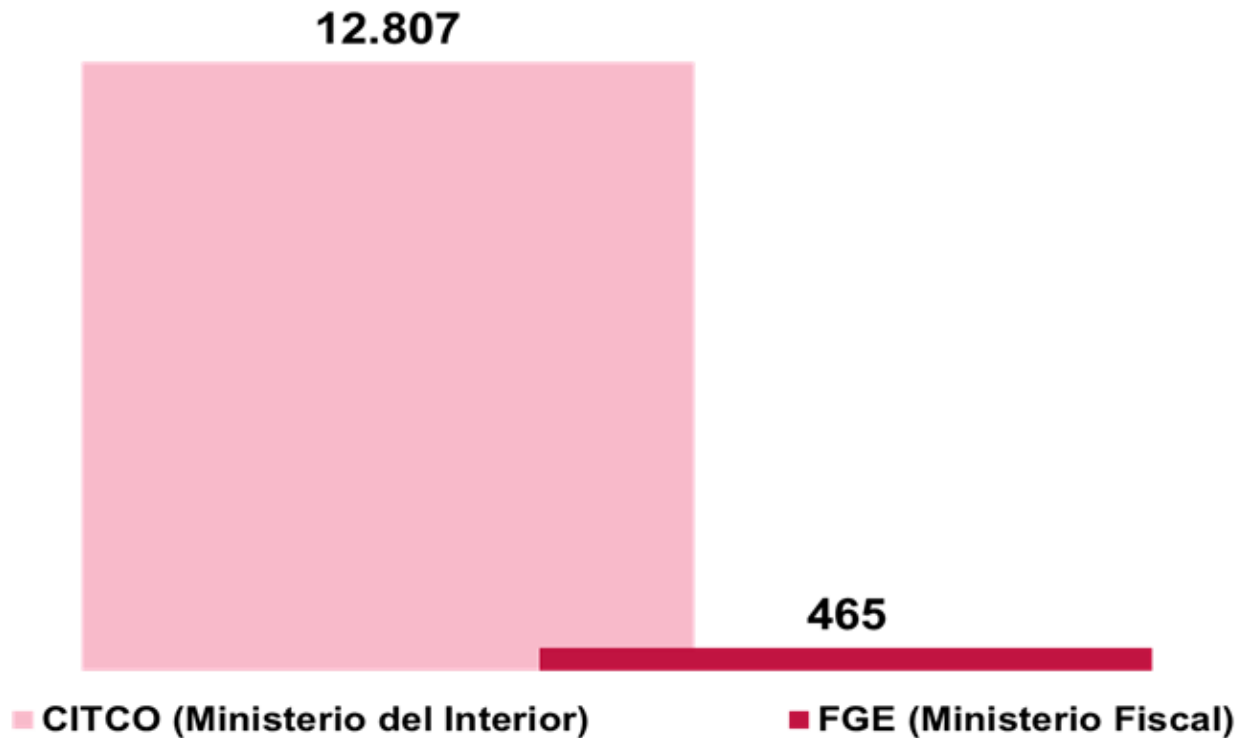
A Vision Based on Rights:

SURVIVORS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

- *Shed light upon the matter, end with their anonymity*
- *Incorporate their narrative*
- *Recognize their own surviving strategies: sisterhood and mutual care*

A criminal Procedure that RESTORES RIGHTS

- Justiciability
- Availability
- Accessibility
- Softening of the concept: cooperation with legal authorities
- Victim and witness protection over the entire national territory
- Difficulty to protect families in originLegal resources for victims

Child Protection System: from protection to risk

- Gaps in the protection of minors who are victims of human trafficking
- Protocol to establish age
- Lack of intersectionality
- Intrinsic vulnerability of minors
- Risk of internal human trafficking

The need to rethink the borders

- Reverse the existing logic at the borders
- Identify the border as a place of risk
- Acknowledge transborder strategies of the networks and the victims

Administrative procedure, another way to ensure rights

- Priority to access procedures to legalize the administrative situation.
- Removal of administrative obstacles to facilitate social inclusion.
- Organic Law 4/2015, on the Protection of Public Safety, March 30th: the contradiction of protection.
